Changes in the course will be adapted as per RTM Nagpur University Instructions. NEP will be implemented as per instructions given by the state government and RTM Nagpur University

Certificate Courses

Programs are specially designed add-on, value addition, knowledge enrichment, skill development, employment/ self-employment generation modules developed by college, adapted by CDC. These are recommended in addition to selected B. Com program and separate fees are applicable. After successful completion of program certificate is issued by college.

Each certificate program has total 30 study hours including practical along with home assignment Available Certificate Course in Commerce & Management are

- 1. Certificate Course on Tally with GST
- 2. Certificate Course on English grammar & communication Skill

Eligibility for admission

First Year Undergraduate:

The student who have passed Higher Secondary School Certificate Examination from Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education or equivalent shall be eligible for admission to B.Com. Part-I and of the three years Degree course.

Second and Third Year Undergraduate:

The Student who have passed B.Com. Part-I or Part-II or equivalent examination shall be admitted to the second year of the respective classes. Students promoted under ATKT rules are also eligible.

Environment Studies:

B.Com Part II Student will have to pass in the examination of this course in order to obtain degree certificate from University. In case the student remains absent or fails to clear the course in the second year, he will have to clear the course in the third year. The course fee is Rs. 100/- as prescribed by R.T.M. Nagpur University.

Rules for Admission:

The admission to the undergraduate class shall be according to the rules and regulations of the Rashtrasant Tukdoji Maharaj NagpurUniversity and the State Government.

- (A)The Original Transfer Certificate of the last educational institution attended is essential for admission. The Certificate will not be returned once admitted to the college.
 - There will be no admission on the basis of the Duplicate Transfer Certificate.
- (B) The fees once paid will not be refunded to the student who cancels his admission or leaves the college
- (C)As per UGC norms, the sports persons shall be given preference in admission.
- (D)The last date of admission to the college shall be according to the date fixed by Rashtrasant Tukdoji Maharaj Nagpur University.
- (E) The decision of the Principal of the college regarding to the admission shall remain final

- 5. Signature of father is required in ink.
- 6. If father is alive, father's signature is required. If not mother's signature is required
- 7. Income Tax is paid or not. If not, please attach a certificate that father/ guardian is not an Income Tax payee
- 8. If father and mother live separately, judicial separation certificate is to be attached
- 9. If father is retired, Pension certificate is required
- 10. If caste is not mentioned in School Leaving Certificate, students should not apply for G.O.I. (Government of India) Scholarship
- 11. Attested Marks List of Exam, passed is to be attached
- 12. If parent's/guardian's income is below Rs. 1, 00,000/- per year (For BC/ NT/OBC), Rs. 2, 00,000/- per year for SC students should not apply for G.O.I. scholarship

Government may reject the form if it's not complete in every respect. College is not responsible for non-sanction of scholarship generally form is rejected for final year.

Scholarship / Concessions / Freeship

The following Scholarships/Concessions/Freeships are available:-

- 1. Govt. of India Scholarship /E.B.C. concession/ Freeship / Rajeshri Shahu Maharaj open Category Scholarship
- 2. Minority Scholarship

In case of rejection of scholarship application by govt /authorities, Full fees will be applicable.

Scholarship on Merit Basis

1. Students scoring more than 85% and above in XII (English medium) will get full fees concession in B.Com I

2. Students scoring more than 75-84.99% in XII (English medium) will get 50% fees concession in B.Com I

3. Students scoring more than 85% and above in B.Com I and II year will get full fees concession for next class.

4. Students scoring more than 75-84.99% in B.Com I and II year will get 50% fees concession for next class.

Applicable / Payable Fees:

- *Important Note:* The annual tuition fees for the First & Second year of Commerce faculty will be charged as prescribed by RTM Nagpur University. That can be changed as per modifications by University/Government.
- The student from University other than Rashtrasant Tukdoji Maharaj Nagpur University shall have to pay Rs.200/- as migration fee. She will have to produce Migration Certificate on or before 15th September. The admission will be cancelled if the above requirement is not fulfilled within the said period.
- The candidate leaving the college in the middle of the session cannot obtain Transfer Certificate unless she pays the fees for complete session of the college.
- The student will have to pay Rs.50/- for the Duplicate College Transfer Certificate after producing the court affidavit. For obtaining duplicate of other documents she will be required to pay Rs. 10/- per document
- Based on selected services other fees applicable: Examination fees, Security charges, selffinance program fees, e-transaction fees, Caution money deposit, Book bank deposit, Counseling Charges, Contributions for Academic / Study tour/ field visit, etc.

Awards:

College has constituted many awards for promising students they are as follows.

- 4. Library User Award: A award is constituted for the students who visits the library and reading room maximum number of times in the session.

University examination

As per the University rules 75% **attendance** in each subject is compulsory. Otherwise the student will be not been allowed to appear in the University examination. In such case, the college does not bear responsibility for the loss of one year of the student.

Library

The college has a library as well as a Reading Room. Books borrowed from Library should be handled with care and return within the specified time. If the book is lost or torn, the same will have to be replaced. The current cost of the book may be accepted under special circumstances.

Reading room

The college has a well maintained Reading Room with English, Marathi, Hindi and Gujarati daily newspapers, weekly, fortnightly and monthly magazines. The magazines and journals are related to the subjects like Economics, Commerce, Science, Computer, Sports, Literature and General Knowledge. Entry into The Reading Room without the Identity Card is not permitted.

Physical efficiency test

Physical efficiency test is conducted by Nagpur University during January or February. The student who remain absent during this test can be disallowed to appear in the University Examination. The college will not be responsible for the consequences of the absence in the test.

Parking facility

Student who wants to keep their vehicles in the college will have to pay Rs. 350/- for parking facility. The college will not be responsible for the theft of the vehicles in the college. Locking of the parked vehicle is compulsory. Students should have valid driving license with them.

Committees & Cells

Some important committees' in Institution are....

Internal Quality Assurance Cell

This cell has focused on quality parameters and standards through IQAS. The cell conducts regular surveys and feedback on curriculum, teaching learning, infrastructure, events and activities.

Anti-Ragging

College has zero tolerance policy against any sort of ragging or similar activities. Anti-Ragging

Committee creates awareness among the students about ragging and its side effects. The committee is empowered to take strict and strong action in case such incidents are found.

Students Grievance and Redressal Cell

College Grievance and Redressal Cell (CGRC) addressed all sorts of grievances raised by enrolled student of college. Committee resolves the grievance by following the principles of natural justice. All complaints of students should be first addressed to CGRC.

ICC (Internal Complaints Committee)

Institute has established Internal Complaints Committee under the norms of UGC regulations 2015 to regulate Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal of Sexual Harassment of Women Employees and students in Higher Educational Institutions. Institution has zero tolerance policy and adapts quasi-judicial procedures for processing any complaint received.

Placement and Students progression Committee

Rules of conduct of Students

- 1. Entry into the college premises without Identity Card is prohibited. The student must carry the Identity Card as long as they are in college premises.
- 2. Student should come to the college in full uniform.
- 3. Students must obey the orders issued by the Principal. Students will be held responsible for the misbehavior either in college premises or outside. She may be expelled from the college in case of indiscipline or rude behavior. It is presumed that the guardians know and agree to the rules while admitting their wards to the college.
- 4. The behavior of students toward teachers, office staff and the classmates should be proper. Otherwise strict action will be taken against students for the same.
- 5. Ragging is strictly prohibited. Immediate action will be taken against students / students found guilty of ragging, as per the Maharashtra State Rules
- 6. No student is allowed to publish any information regarding college administration in the newspaper without the prior permission of the Principal. Breach of this rule may result Expulsion of the student from the college.
- 7. The students should attend their classes regularly and should occupy their seats before the entry of the teacher in the classroom. They should not bring any person in the college premises who is not a student this college.
- 8. There should be perfect silence during the lecture in the class. The students should spend their leisure time in the Library, Reading Room or Student's Common Room without disturbing the working of the college. Loitering in the veranda is strictly prohibited.

- 9. The student should send the application for leave well in advance signed by her parents / guardian if she wants to remain absent on some ground. In case of ill health, if the absence is more than three days. She must submit the medical certificate certified by a Registered Medical Practione
- 10. Students should not arrange any activity like invitation to any person for the programme, picnic or formation of the committee without the prior permission of the Principal. Students must seek Principal's permission to arrange any academic or cultural activity like Group Discussion or Debate etc.
- 11. It is expected that the student will be careful while handling instrument, apparatus and utilizing electricity, furniture or any movable or, immovable property of the college. Strict action will be taken against the student in case of the damage to the college property.
- 12. Only the special instructions are conveyed in the classroom. Hence student should read the instruction on thenotice board daily.
- 13. The student should inform the college office about the change in her permanent or local address.
- 14. The student should obtain the Identity Card immediately after the admission on submitting the recent passport size photograph (5x6.5cm) Payment of Rs. 50/- for the Identity Card is compulsory.
- 15. The student may be expelled from the college in case of copying or using unfair means in examination orviolating any rules.
- 16. Rules regarding Games and Sports framed by the Committee must be followed compulsory.
- 17. Use of Mobile phone is prohibited in the college.
- 18. It is OBLIGATORY on the part of the student to follow the rules formulated by the Principal of the college from time to time. Principal's decision is final.
